Md. BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS Code Ann. § 13-707 (2013)

§ 13-707. Penalties

- (a) In general. -- A person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$ 1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.
- (b) Limitation. -- The fines assessed under §§ 13-313 and 13-409 of this title may not exceed \$ 5,000 per violation, or a maximum aggregate of \$ 10,000 for a 2-year license term, and shall be paid to the Secretary within 10 days after final adjudication of any hearing or upon the waiver of any hearing.
- (c) Who may be assessed fines. -- Notwithstanding the provisions of §§ 13-313 and 13-409 of this title, the Secretary may fine either the licensed agency or the individual working on behalf of the licensed agency, but not both, for the same violation.
