

### Firearms Services Program

- For Firearms Services Select "Firearm Services" for Program
- **Handgun Qualification License (Standard)**
  - Required to purchase, rent, or receive a regulated firearm in Maryland
  - Select "HQL Standard" for License Type, and "Application" for Application Method
  - Required to have taken the 4 hour class from a certified MSP Instructor
- **Handgun Qualification License (Training Exempt)**
  - Required to purchase, rent, or receive a regulated firearm in Maryland
  - Select "HQL Training Exempt" for License Type, and "Application" for Application Method
  - See website for list of exemptions
- **Handgun Qualification License (Permit Exempt)**
  - Required to purchase, rent, or receive a regulated firearm in Maryland
  - Select "HQL Permit Exempt" for License Type, and "Application" for Application Method
  - Must have a valid MD wear & carry license
- **New Resident Regulated Firearms Registration**
  - A person shall, within 90 days after establishing residency, register all regulated firearms with the Secretary of the Maryland Department of State Police.
  - Select "New Resident Regulated Firearms Registration" for License Type, and "Application" for Application Method

## Register Your Device

Maryland Law provides that law enforcement agencies in the State shall register with the Maryland Department of State Police all electronic, mechanical, or other devices whose design renders them primarily useful for the purpose of the surreptitious interception of wire, oral, or electronic communications.

The device is required to be owned, possessed or in the control of the agency, its employees or agents. All devices shall be registered within ten (10) days of the date the device came into the possession or the control of the agency, their employees or agents.

Upon successful registration of a device, a corresponding license number will be issued and forwarded to the registering agency. The law requires the registering agency; employees or agents affix the issued serial number for each device registered.

### Attestation

Maryland Law provides that Law Enforcement Agencies in the State shall register with the Maryland State Police ALL electronic, mechanical or other devices whose design renders them PRIMARILY useful for the purpose of the SURREPTITIOUS interception of wire, oral or electronic communications which are owned by them or possessed by or in the control of the agency, their employees or agents. All such devices shall be registered within ten (10) days from the date on which the device came into the possession or control of the agency, their employees or agents. The law further requires the requesting agency, employees or agents affix or indicate an issued serial number for each device registered pursuant to this law on the device registered. Changes to any information supplied as part of the registration must be reported promptly to the Maryland Department of State Police.
